Times: 9:00am-12:00pm

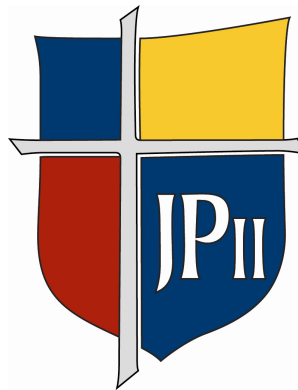
*The last hour of camp on Thursday will include a special presentation for parents.
