

Field Procedures

Players, siblings, etc., must stay off of the fields that we are not using for games. Most of the time these fields have been prepped for a later game and will need to be re-worked if the kids are out playing on them. We could incur fees if the city needs to be called out to prep the fields again.

Pets are not to be brought to the ball games. **This is a city ordinance.**

All trash from the stands, dug-outs, etc., must be picked up and placed in the trash bins after each game. Please make sure the fields are left clean for the next group.

Breckenridge:

If you are the last game of the day, please place the tarps on the mound so that it is completely covered. Bases need to be picked up and placed in the orange bins located in the dug-out and the plugs placed in the holes. Failure to cover the mound properly will result in a \$50 fine assessed to the last 2 teams that play on the field.

FIELD INFORMATION FOR OG 1 AND OG 2

Restrooms are across the street behind the concession building. Warm ups are not allowed on the two fields that are across the street. The home team of the last game will need to put the bases by the storage container under the scoreboard table at OG 2. Please replace the plugs that are in the 3rd base dugout. Please pick up all trash left in the bleachers and dugouts after each game. The DPL requires that no pets be brought to the fields. These fields are within a public park so children need to be watched carefully and escorted to the restrooms. There are no bicycles, skateboards, scooters, roller blades etc. allowed at the ball field. Do not allow children to climb on railings, fences, or field tarps. There are no alcohol or tobacco products allowed per city ordinance.

FIELD INFORMATION FOR OG 3, 4, 5, 6

Restrooms are located in the center of the four-plex on the side of field 5. Warm ups are not allowed on any fields that are not being used. The home team of the last game will need to pick up bases and replace the plugs. The plugs will be located in the third base dugouts of all four fields. Take the bases to the closet on the right side of the restrooms. That closet faces field 5. **DO NOT REMOVE THE PITCHING PLATES AT 40', 42' OR 45'.** The only pitching plate that should be removed is the JV softball pitching plate at 35' (ONLY LABELED MIS) Do not remove the 35' plate if it is not marked MIS. That pitching plate along with the nails needs to be taken to the same closet as the bases. Please pick up all trash left in the bleachers and dugouts after each game. The DPL requires that no pets be brought to any of the ball fields. Do not allow children to climb on the railings, field tarps or fences. These fields are within a public park so children need to be watched carefully and escorted to the restrooms. There are no bicycles, skateboards, scooters, roller blades etc. allowed at the ball field. There are no alcohol or tobacco products allowed per city ordinance.

For all fields:

No tobacco or alcohol is permitted in the parks or anytime during a DPL event.
